## **EXPLORE COUITER'S BROOK**

**Discover on foot South Bristol's** Colliter's Brook, its abundant plants and wildlife, stunning views and secret footpaths.

Try a short stroll on the public footpaths alongside the brook, where you might spot kingfishers, little egrets or (if you're lucky) otters! Other footpaths will take you near the brook, alongside wetlands, through Bristol's last working farm or to panoramic views over south Bristol.

You could even track the brook along publicly accessible footpaths for its whole 6.5km length, from **Dundry Hill to the New Cut near Clifton Suspension Bridge.** 

Some roads, junctions and paths have been omitted or simplified for clarity. Some routes have stiles or gates, and may be narrow or uneven in the upstream areas.
